



MEAL CHARGE POLICY

1. Adults shall not charge any purchases in the School Cafeteria.
2. A la carte purchases shall not be charged. Additionally, if a student has a balance from prior charged meals, they will not be allowed to purchase a la carte items until the charges are cleared from their account.
3. Elementary students will be allowed to charge up to \$20.00. When a Student account exceeds \$20.00, a notice will be sent home to parents by Student. Additionally, the parent will receive a call from the Food Service Manager. If the student has no money or brings no lunch from home after the attempt is made to contact the parent, then the situation will be referred to the Principal and Financial Officer of Students with unpaid charges.
4. Secondary school student will be allowed a 3 meal limit. When the limit is met, a notice is sent home to the parent by the student. Additionally, the parent will receive a call, followed by a letter from the Food Service Manager. If the account is not cleared the student will not be allowed to purchase a la carte item.

We believe that all students require a healthy and nutritional meal in order to give their best effort in pursuit of their educational goals. It is with this belief that we implement this policy, to ensure that all students are provided the best meal possible in a fair and equitable manner.
