- Welcome & Introductions Terry Watson, Board Chair

  - Forecast for FAMU DRS
    - Revise schedule for Elementary and Middle School (See Attached Schedule)
      - Current Schedule

        - Middle School: 8:15am -3:15pm
        - High School: 8:15am-3:15pm
      - Middle school needs a little head start for the day
      - Question: Can this be structured as research?
        - Dr. Hodge- This definitely is one piece to the entire proposed program. Middle School will be an academy. Middle school students are struggling. The curriculum will change to common core standards across the board. We are also looking at offering AICE program. Tallahassee Leon county does not have the program. They are college credit classes that can be used for Bright Futures upon completion. Middle School will be contained in one building with one schedule. example schedule:
